

I. General Information

1. All show information, registration forms, etc., are available on the ABHA website at www.blackhereford.org
2. All animals must be registered/recorded in the ABHA
3. The owner of the animal(s) being exhibited must be in good standing with the Association
4. Each animal must be in the owners recorded ownership by October 2, 2018
- 5 The entry fee for exhibition is \$25 per animal
- 6 Show Registrations must be postmarked by October 2, 2018.
7. Registration/Entry: Registration/Entry form(s) and payment should be filled out completely and submitted by the set deadline. The Registration/Entry form(s) can be submitted electronically on line though the ABHA website or print and submitted by mail to the below address. Credit Cards can be accepted as payment if completed online, an invoice will then be generated for payment.

Entries must be postmarked on, or before, the entry deadline indicated for each show. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. No substitutes will be accepted after the entry deadline. The member entering in the show is responsible to make sure that the entries are mailed and postmarked to meet all the entry requirements. The ABHA is not responsible for entries that are mishandled, incorrectly postmarked or not delivered by the United States Postal Service, United Parcel Service, Federal Express or any other carrier.

NOTE: "Postmarked" means postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service. Privately metered entries and applications will not be accepted. When sending entries by mail, it is highly encouraged to use overnight, registered or certified mail services.

8 Animals will be accepted on Wednesday November 7, 2018 from 9am to 9pm and Thursday, November 8 2018, from 9 am to 12 pm local time. They will be

checked in by ABHA Reps and the breeder will be assigned an indoor tie up or pen. They will also be shown an outdoor tie out for haltered cattle if the exhibitor wants to tie out overnight.

9. NO animals are allowed in the Barn prior to 9 am Wednesday, November 7 2018.

10. All entries must be halter broken to be exhibited in the haltered show. Pens of three heifers may be exhibited in the “Pen of Three” event and are not required to be halter broken.

11. Each exhibitor can bring 3 pens of Three, if exhibiting 2 pens, one pen must sell. If exhibiting 3 pens, 2 pens must sell.

12. Any heifer registered as a heifer, that calves prior to show day, will be moved to the respective cow calf pair class.

13. Only straw can be utilized in the show barn area. No wood chips or sawdust can be used.

14. NO DOGS will be allowed in the barn area or show arena.

15. NO Alcohol on the premise.

16. There will be designated time announced for you to officially check in your haltered animals. You are required to bring your animal at that time to the designated area for check in. Tattoos, ID and all required health papers and registration papers must be presented and in order.

17. Pens of Three will have tattoos and ID checked by staff. Health and registration papers must be in order and presented to show officials.

18. Only HB animals may participate in the cow calf show. No HX or F1 are eligible.

II. FITTING AND SHOWING GUIDELINES

1. Only one person will be allowed to lead each entry in the showing.
2. Any exhibitor who loses control of his/her entry more than twice in the showing will be asked to remove the animal from the ring.
3. All entries must be on time for their respective class. Once the entries in the exhibitor's respective class have begun walking into the profile view, the exhibitor is too late and ineligible to compete.
4. All bulls must be shown with a nose lead.
5. Each exhibitor is responsible for having his/her animal(s) presented in its natural conformation and structure without alteration or modification, except for the grooming of hair and hooves. The exhibition of cattle displaying false hair will not be allowed. Painting of white skin and surgical alteration of an animal's conformation or appearance is prohibited.

Altering the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair), with the exception of false tail switches. The use of graphite, powders, hemp or other similar substances used externally are also prohibited. Other prohibited products include those used internally such as steroids, illegal or unlicensed pharmaceuticals or artificial filling. Any animal found to be in violation will be barred from showing.

All entries are subject to visual inspection and/or laboratory testing. The exhibitor of any entry found to be in violation of the above rules will be disqualified from exhibiting at future Association-sponsored shows.

6. The act of artificially filling animals internally, which includes stomach pumping, drench tubes or any other method by mouth or esophagus is prohibited.
7. Any animal upon check-in, which does not have legible permanent identification marks (ear tattoo)

Corresponding to the permanent identification on its registration certificate, is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect, illegible, or absence of a permanent identification mark, animals cannot be permanently identified and

re-checked at the show.

8. All entries must meet Missouri Health Regulations. Entries must have a current official health certificate from your veterinarian. Missouri Law specifies that all animals have a Metal ID Tag to enter/exit the state. Make sure that all Missouri health regulations are met.

9. The individual classes will be made up and divided after the cattle are checked in at the show. They will be judged from the youngest class to the oldest within each class.

10. Calves on the side of cow-calf pairs **MUST BE** the cow's natural calf.

11. Each exhibitor must wear registration/entry numbers on their backs.

12. If all the rules, regulations and requirement of the show are not met, the show management reserves the right to disqualify any entry.

Bull Show Classifications:

Bulls will be shown in two classifications: Percentage (62.5 – 87.49% Hereford Blood) Purebred (87.5% or Higher Hereford Blood)

Bulls will be shown in three Divisions: Calf Division (Born Jan 1, 2018 and after) Junior Division (Born Jan 1, 2017 – Dec 31, 2017) Senior Division (Born Nov 1, 2015 – Dec 31, 2016)

Classes will be determined after all show entries are processed. There will be no more than a 60 day spread of age in any class and no more than 8 animals in an individual class.

Special Bull rules and regulations:

1. ALL bulls will have a halter; neck rope and nose lead in at all times. 2. Bulls are not eligible to sell. Bulls must be 36 months or younger

Heifer Show Classifications:

Haltered Heifer Exhibition HX or F1 (are not eligible to compete for overall champion) F1 (50% Angus/50% Hereford) Percentage (62.5 – 87.49% Hereford Blood) Purebred (87.5% or Higher Hereford Blood)

Haltered heifers will be shown in three Divisions: Calf Division (Born Jan 1, 2018 and after) intermediate Division (Born July 1st 2017-Ded.31st2017) Junior division Jna1 2017 -June 30th 2017) Senior Division (Born Nov 1, 2016 – Dec 31, 2016)

Haltered classes will be determined after all show entries are processed. There will be no more than a 60-day spread of age in any class and no more than 8 animals in an individual class.

Cow Calf Pair Classification Animals will be broken into divisions and classes based upon the calf's bloodline. All calves are to be under the maximum BIF weaning age of 250 days. No calves born prior to April 1, 2018 will be eligible to show.

For the overall working of the event, the participant will maintain control, custody, care and feeding for any and all animals and/ or personal property in accordance with rules and regulations of the event, and in no way will the Association be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur or be caused by any animal or personal property.

By entry in this event, I grant permission to the ABHA and any organization associated with the ABHA to use, for any legitimate purpose, including future

advertising of the Activity on the ABHA website or in other promotional materials, my name and likeness to the extent it may appear in any photographs, video or records of the Activity.

By submitting an application, participants agree to comply with all the rules and regulations governing the American Black Hereford Association. Further, these provisions include total ownership of the entry for the prescribed number of days, continuous possession and care and provisions against unethical fitting, filling, and/or alteration of conformation and color of animals(s), meat tampering and illegal or non-approved use of drugs, medication and/or prohibited substance.
