

Qualifications for Dam of Supremacy

- a. Weaned a calf born since Jan. 1, prior to the qualifying year.
- b. Produced at least three calves.
- c. Initially calved at 30 months of age or less.
- d. Had an interval between the first and second calves of no greater than 400 days. In addition, a 370-day calving interval must have been maintained after her second calf. The longer initial calving interval allows breeders to calve 2-year-old heifers prior to the mature cow herd.
- e. Had weaning records submitted to the ABHA for every calf produced that was born before eight months before the date of the award determination of the qualifying year.
- f. Had a 3 year progeny average 205-day adjusted weaning weight ratio of at least 105.
- g. All weights must fall within BIF guidelines
